Shirts will be sold during promotion night at PR, at just above cost. Remaining inventory will be sold during Distribution Days. The graphic will be simple and not advertising the status of Freshman. Treasurer's Report: Tatiana reported an opening balance of \$85,953. Total revenue was \$2,552 vs. expenses of \$55,215. Ending balance is \$33,290, which includes the \$50,000 in Allocations that were awarded, but excludes upcoming scholarship awards, as well as the payout for the Ridge Raffle at Rookies.

Secretary Report: Margie Palmer reported on the status of the Scholarship Application process. This year, 19 applications were received. All applicants are incredibly deserving, and deciding will be difficult. Announcements will be made at the May meeting.

Team and Activity Representatives Report:

Track & Field: Heather Jewel reported via email on Girls Track for the 2024 season. The indoor season was short with just two meets, plus Conference where the girls came in 3rd behind Huntley and Burlington Central – both Class 3A. Five athletes represented Prairie Ridge at the Class 2A Indoor State Meet at Illinois Wesleyan. Junior Katie Jewell took 3rd place in the 60M, tying the school record she set previously this season, and 10th in the 200M with a new indoor PR. Senior Olivia McPherson, sophomore Brenna Benjamin, sophomore Lila Stewart and senior Faith Wilder placed 8th in the 4x800M relay. Lila and Faith also competed in individual events, the 800M and 400M, respectively.

The outdoor season kicked off today at Burlington Central, followed by Grayslake Central Invitational (Thursday) and Barrington Invitational (Friday). We anticipate sending several athletes across multiple events to compete at the Class 2A State Meet May 17th and 18th at Eastern Illinois University (Big Blue).
